- 1) Every hour a soup company produces 583 liters of soup. How much soup would the company have made after 19 hours?
- 2) A pizza chain uses 987 grams of cheese on their pizzas. If they sold 12 pizzas, how many grams would they have used?
- 3) A new library received 667 boxes of books with 74 books in each box. How many books did the library receive total?
- 4) A school bought 509 boxes of computer paper for the computer lab. Each box had 62 sheets of paper inside it. How much paper did they buy total?
- 5) There are 300 hotels in a hotel chain. If each hotel has 61 rooms, how many rooms are there total?
- 6) A race was 736 meters. If 83 people ran in the marathon how many meters would they have run total?
- 7) A farmer has 331 rows of corn. If he can get 42 ears of corn from each row, how many ears of corn would he have total?
- 8) A coat manufacturer puts 230 coats in a shipment. If they sent out 16 shipments, how many coats would they have sent out?
- 9) The ice machine in the lobby of a hotel makes 167 pieces of ice a day. How much ice would it have made if it ran for 26 days?
- 10) A mail sorting machine can sort 828 pieces of mail an hour. If it ran for 39 hour, how many pieces of mail would it have sorted?
