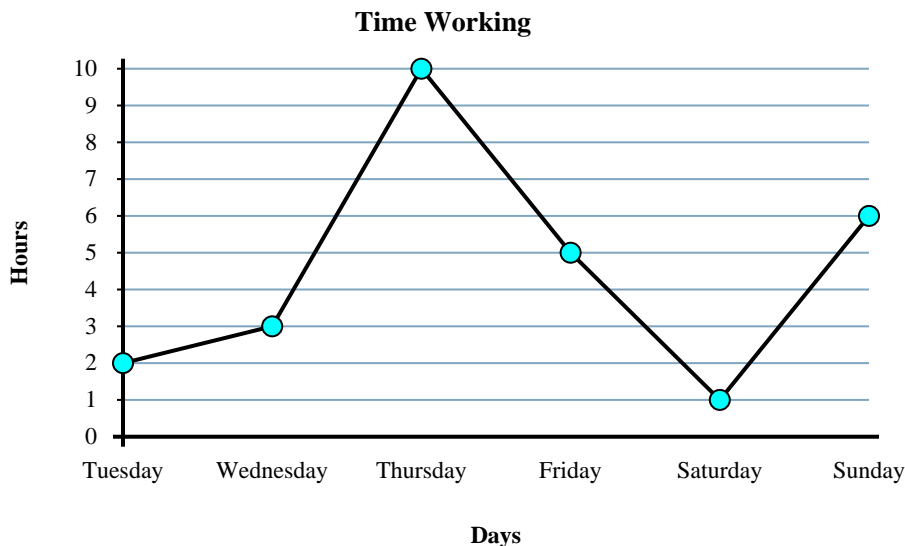




The graph below shows the hours Sarah worked each day of the week. Use the graph to answer the questions.

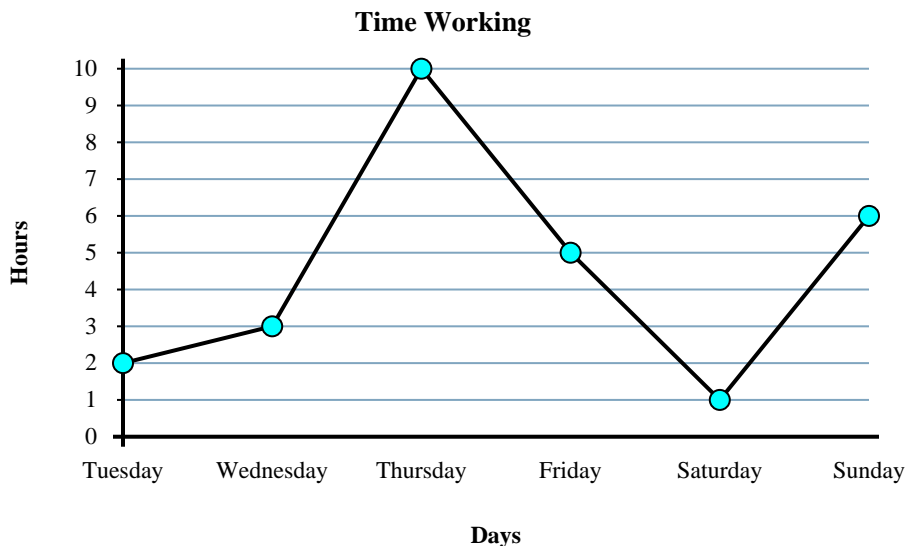
